

Sergeant Major (SGM) TERRENCE BOLGER U.S. Army Reserve Egypt 1985 - 1987, Korea 1995-1996, Saudi Arabia - Desert Shield/Storm 1990- 1991 Iraq/Kuwait - Operation Iraqi Freedom 2004-2005

SGM Bolger entered the U.S. Army Reserve in November 1971 as a 94 B, at Fort Jackson, South Carolina. He was assigned to the 475th Quartermaster Group, Farrell, PA. He was awarded the 92F MOS in 1982 and has performed that MOS since awarded.

SGM Bolger held Leadership positions within the 475th QM GP as a Squad Leader, Platoon Sergeant, Petroleum Pipeline Inspector, Petroleum Distribution Sergeant, Petroleum Operations Sergeant Major. He is a graduate of the United States Army Sergeants Major Academy and all Non-Commissioned Officer Education System courses.

SGM Bolger participated in exercises in Egypt, "Bright Star" in 1985, a987; in Korea, "Ulchi Focus Lens" 1995, 1996. His wartime experience was in Saudi Arabia, "Desert Shield/Storm" 1990 - 1991, and, Iraq/Kuwait, "Operation Iraqi Freedom" 2004-2005.

In his civilian occupation, he was employed with Dept. of the Army as a Military Technician. He retired from both the military and civilian employment in 2011. He is a member of the Wheatland American Legion/West Middlesex VFW Honor Guard.
